ACADEMIC REQUIREMENTS

Undergraduate (Bachelor)

For entry to an undergraduate degree, students must have completed Year 12 with a minimum of 6.5/10 and completed a one-year foundation studies programme.

Students may be considered for advanced entry to undergraduate programmes if they have completed a period of study at university.

Students who have completed Year 1 of University in Vietnam, may be able to enter on to Year 1 entry of an undergraduate degree at Middlesex.

Students who do not meet the above requirements may be considered for a one-year Foundation programme. Find out more: mdx.ac.uk/foundation

Postgraduate (Master)

MA/ MSC: Students must have completed a University degree in Vietnam (4 years study).

MBA: Students must have completed a University degree in Vietnam (4 years study), plus minimum 3 years of working experience in a managerial role.

ENGLISH LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS

We accept a range of English tests, valid within two years of course starting, including:

Undergraduate (Bachelor) course

— IELTS 6.0 (with minimum 5.5 in all components)

Postgraduate (Master) course

— IELTS 6.5 (with minimum 6.0 in all components)

We also offer pre-sessional English courses to students who need to improve their English level to study with us.
